BUDGET COMMITTEE

THURSDAY, MAY 14, 2020, 2:00 P.M.**

Old Business

1. Review of Revenues and Expenditures (and Transfers) and any accounts or related issues pertaining to the FY 2020-2022 Biennial Budget. City Manager Christopher Shrout introduced Item 1, and Finance Director Robert Saucedo discussed the budget. Both answered questions from the Committee members. Lead Building Inspector Tanner Rush spoke about the changes to the inspection fees. Deputy Finance Director Walter Gerow spoke about the utility fees. The following changes were recommended:
  - Fixing typo in Total Valuation to read “\$40,000.01” instead of “\$10,000.01”
  - Raise reconnect fee from \$50 to \$70
  - Raise leak check fee from \$20 to \$25

Assistant City Manager Robert Carr gave an update on G.O. Bond fund issues. City Engineer Christopher Robinson also answered questions.

No vote was taken.
