He also briefing explained the difference between Revenue Bonds and G.O. Bonds. Greg Nieto with The Baker Group went into detail about the available options for financing the projects including current interest rates. Councilor Gary Isbell suggested a new project for the Park West off Main St. His suggestion included installing artificial turf on the football field and triple striping it for football, soccer, and lacrosse, in addition to installing a pedestrian bridge across Pole Cat Creek to expand the existing park system.
