

OPENING JENKS GUIDELINE SUMMARY

BASED OFF WHITE HOUSE "OPENING AMERICA AGAIN" AND
GOVERNOR STITT'S STATE RECOMMENDATIONS

GATING CRITERIA

MUST BE SATISFIED BEFORE PROCEEDING TO PHASED OPENING

SYMPTOMS

Downward trajectory of influenza-like illnesses reported within a 14-day period

AND

Downward trajectory of covid-like syndromic cases reported within a 14-day period

CASES

Downward trajectory of documented cases within a 14-day period

OR

Downward trajectory of positive tests as a percent of total tests within a 14-day period (flat or increasing volume of tests)

HOSPITALS

Treat all patients without crisis care

AND

Robust testing program in place for at-risk healthcare workers, including emerging antibody testing

PHASES

ONE, TWO & THREE

The goal is to open Jenks in phases based on up-to-date data and readiness (data from Department of Health). We want to protect the most vulnerable and to mitigate the risk of resurgence. **These phases will be implemented based on state and county data and/or the recommendations of the Governor.** Each phase must maintain at least 14 days of gating criteria before moving to the next phase.

INDIVIDUALS

All vulnerable individuals continue to shelter in place.

All individuals when in public should remain 6 feet away from others and avoid social settings of 10 or more people.

Avoid all socializing in groups of more than 10 people in circumstances that do not allow for appropriate distancing of 6 feet apart.

Minimize non-essential travel and follow CDC guidelines regarding isolation following travel.

SPECIFIC EMPLOYERS

Schools and organized youth activities that are currently closed should remain closed. This would include youth sports at ParkWest and school sports.

Visitors are still prohibited to senior living facilities and hospitals. Those who do interact with residents and patients must adhere to strict protocols regarding hygiene.

Gyms, Nail and Hair Salons can open with strict physical distancing and sanitation protocols:

- Maintain at least 6 feet between individuals
- Equipment and common areas must be sanitized between each use
- Face coverings strongly recommended for workers and customers in hair and nail salons, barber shops, and spas

Elective surgeries can resume, as clinically appropriate or an outpatient basis at facilities that adhere to CMS guidelines.

Bars should remain closed.

CITY OF JENKS EMPLOYEES AND FACILITIES

City employees will continue to telework whenever possible.

City employees will continue to wear masks on city property when in common areas or around others.

City employees will continue to adhere to no work travel and minimize non-essential personal travel. If travel is necessary, employees must adhere to CDC guidelines regarding isolation following travel.

City Hall community room remains closed.

Utility Billing continues to be online, by phone or through the dropbox.

Jenks Parks (including BarkWest and Jenks Skate Park) all open with social distancing in effect. Restrooms at parks remain closed.

No Special Events Permits during this time.

SPECIFIC EMPLOYERS

Large venues can operate under strict physical distancing protocols:

- Sit-Down Dining – tables must be at least 6 feet apart. Parties are limited to groups of 10 people or less.
- Places of Worship – encourage face coverings for attendees, require 6 feet of social distancing between family groups and/or individuals and continue to adhere CDC recommendations for places of worship (eliminate handshakes, cup sharing, social gatherings after services, etc.) Nurseries must remain closed and no food/beverage services allowed during this time.
- Entertainment venues- minimize attendance capacity to require 6 feet of social distancing between groups and encourage attendees to wear simple face coverings.

INDIVIDUALS

All vulnerable individuals continue to shelter in place.

All individuals when in public should remain 6 feet away from others and avoid social settings of 50 or more people.

Avoid all socializing in groups of more than 50 people in circumstances that do not allow for appropriate distancing of 6 feet apart.

Neighborhood garage sale events or estate sales allowed with less than 50 gathered people at a time, social distancing in effect and simple face coverings encouraged by attendees and hosts.

Non-essential travel can resume.

SPECIFIC EMPLOYERS

Schools and organized youth activities may re-open. This would include youth sports at ParkWest and school sports (individual schools determine when they will re-open at this point) so long as they can maintain social distancing when possible and avoid groups of more than 50 people.

Visitors are still prohibited to senior living facilities and hospitals. Those who do interact with residents and patients must adhere to strict protocols regarding hygiene.

Gyms, Nail and Hair Salons can remain open with strict physical distancing and sanitation protocols:

- Maintain at least 6 feet between individuals
- Equipment and common areas must be sanitized between each use

Bars may operate with limited standing-room occupancy, where applicable and appropriate. Tables and/or bar stools must be 6 feet apart for each group of people in attendance.

CITY OF JENKS EMPLOYEES AND FACILITIES

City employees will continue to telework whenever possible.

City employees will follow current CDC recommendations regarding face coverings when on city property.

City employees can resume essential work travel.

Special considerations for personnel who are members of a vulnerable population will be taken into consideration.

Utility Billing window in City Hall open with continued options to pay online, by mail, by phone or dropbox.

Community Room remains closed.

Jenks Parks open with social distancing still in effect. Playground equipment open; restrooms remain closed.

Special Events permits for events with 50 or less people can be submitted online.

SPECIFIC EMPLOYERS

Large venues can operate under moderate physical distancing protocols:

- Sit-Down Dining – tables must be at least 6 feet apart. Parties are limited to groups of 50 people or less.
- Places of Worship – Require 6 feet of social distancing between groups. Special events may be resumed with a maximum of 50 people. Social distancing should still be observed whenever possible.
- Entertainment venues- minimize attendance capacity to require 6 feet of social distancing between groups and encourage attendees to wear simple face coverings. Special events may be resumed with a maximum of 50 people. Social distancing should still be observed whenever possible.

INDIVIDUALS

All citizens over 65 years old and vulnerable individuals should continue to follow safer-at-home policies.

All individuals should minimize time spent in crowded environments and continue following CDC guidelines regarding social distancing.

Visitations to senior care facilities, except for end-of-life situations, will be prohibited until affirmatively lifted by Executive Order.

Visitations to hospitals allowed within the guidelines provided in OURS Plan. More details under “Specific Employers”.

CITY OF JENKS EMPLOYEES AND FACILITIES

City employees will follow current CDC recommendations regarding face coverings when on city property.

Special considerations for personnel who are members of a vulnerable population will be taken into consideration.

Utility Billing window in City Hall open with continued options to pay online, by mail, by phone or dropbox.

Community Room is open for reservations. People ages 65 and over and vulnerable individuals should avoid attending events in Community Room per OURS Plan guidelines.

Jenks Parks open with social distancing still in effect. Playground equipment open; splash pads open; restrooms open; park pavilions available for reservations.

Special Events permits for events can be submitted online. Decisions will be made based off current incident rates and are subject to change based off current data.

SPECIFIC EMPLOYERS

Summer camps (church and school) can open. This decision to open or not lies with the individual camps.

Visitations to senior care facilities, except for end-of-life situations, will be prohibited until affirmatively lifted by Executive Order.

Businesses operating by appointment only may begin operating by appointment or walk-in at their discretion.

Suggested guidelines regarding use of masks and other personal protection equipment in businesses can be found on the CDC website or the OK Dept. of Commerce website.

Businesses can resume unrestrictive staffing at their worksites by observing proper CDC-recommended social distancing protocols and are recommended to continue increased cleaning and disinfecting practices. Unrestrictive staffing is at the discretion of the business.

SPECIFIC EMPLOYERS

Visits to hospitals shall be subject to the following limitations:

1. In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, health care facilities (hospitals, ambulatory surgery centers, outpatient diagnostic centers, and clinics) are uniquely charged with protecting both the health of those they serve and the health of their caregivers. As an essential part of the front line to stopping the community spread of COVID-19, health care facilities should maintain compliance with current CDC guidelines regarding limiting visitation to their facilities through the establishment of policies that limit the number of people who may access their facility.
2. Depending upon the prevalence of community spread and number of suspected or confirmed COVID-19 patients in the facility, in consultation with medical staff, the facility shall determine the visitation policies. If determined that it is safe for the patient and the staff, the following visitation will be allowed in Phases 2 and 3 of the OURS plan:

- Each patient may be permitted one adult Patient Representative to support and assist the patient with receipt of care. The Patient Representative should be the same throughout the admission or visit.
- Additional Patient Representatives may be permitted if exceptional circumstances warrant consideration and in compliance with facility policy.
- Patient Representatives shall be subject to any screening procedures required by the facility including temperature screenings, observance of hand hygiene practices, and the wearing of their own mask at all times while in the facility.
- The facility may further limit access to patients when Patient Representatives fail to follow facility policy.
- Social distancing is required at all time
