Minimum Qualifications

1. Be at least 21 years of age prior to certification as a peace officer
2. Be a United States citizen or in resident alien status, as defined by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services
3. Possess a high school diploma or GED equivalency certificate as recognized by state law
4. Not have been convicted in state or federal court for any felony, crime of moral turpitude, or a crime of domestic abuse
5. Have fingerprint clearance from the FBI and OSBI
6. Have undergone psychological evaluation using a psychological instrument approved by CLEET
7. Not be currently undergoing treatment for a mental illness, condition, or disorder
8. Not be subject to a CLEET order revoking, suspending, or accepting a voluntary surrender of peace officer certification
9. Be commissioned or appointed by the Department prior to attending CLEET-approved certification training
10. Not have been involuntarily committed to an Oklahoma state mental institution
11. Pass a Thorough Background Investigation
12. Oral Board
13. Chief Interview
14. Pension Physical
