

# One Cart Recycling is Here, Jenks!

## You CAN Make a Difference

One cart recycling, gives you an easy way to protect the environment by recycling at no additional cost and with the convenience of curbside pickup. Simply place all your loose recyclables into your city trash cart along with your bags of trash and wheel it out to the curb. We handle it all—including plastics #1 and #2. The trash is converted into energy at our landfill and the recyclables go to the recycling facility still mixed, where an advanced recyclables sorting machine (Mr. Murph) separates the different materials.

### Quick Tips:

- Make sure you **bag your regular trash before placing them in cart**; recyclables should remain loose.
- Rinse food waste and other contaminants from your recyclables.
- No need to remove labels, staples, envelope windows, or sticky notes.
- Make sure items are recyclable before placing them loose in the cart.

## Mix it Up and Roll it Out

- All recyclables are to be placed in this one container (no sorting is required)
- Plastics #1 and #2 are accepted (look on the bottom of containers for numbers enclosed in recycling arrows)
- Collection is every week
- Place your trash/recycling cart facing the street or alley, as you do now.

Metal Food Cans and Their Caps or Lids (Rinsed)  
Soda and Other Aluminum Cans



## PAPER & BOXBOARD

Advertising/Junk Mail, and Envelopes  
Cardboard Boxes  
Cardboard Egg Cartons  
Catalogs, Magazines and Phone Books  
Cereal and Dry Food Boxes (Without Liners)  
Colored or White Paper  
Newspaper  
Paperback Books  
Shredded Paper (Bagged)  
Wrapping Paper (Nonmetallic Only)



## PLASTICS #1 and #2

Bathroom, Kitchen and Window Cleaning Bottles (Rinsed)  
Conditioner and Shampoo Bottles (Rinsed)  
Detergent and Fabric-softener Bottles (Rinsed)  
Food Jars and Squeezable Bottles (Rinsed) (Including Mayonnaise, Mustard, Salad Dressing, Syrup, Vegetable Oils, etc.)  
Milk, Juice, Soda and Other Beverage Bottles and Their Caps (Rinsed)  
Rigid Plastics (Laundry Baskets and Buckets-Must Fit Inside Recycling Cart with Lid Closed)
