The Jenks Police Department is now hiring:

Reserve Police Officers

Minimum Requirements

- Be at least 21 years of age prior to certification as a peace officer.
- Must be a United States citizen or in resident alien status, as defined by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services.
- Must possess a high school diploma or a GED equivalency certificate. (Minimum requirements)
- Must not have been convicted in state or federal court for any felony, crime of moral turpitude, or a crime of domestic violence.
- Must have fingerprint clearance from Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation.
- Must have undergone psychological evaluation by the employing agency using a psychological instrument approved by CLEET.
- Must not have been involuntarily committed to an Oklahoma state mental institution.
- Must certify that he or she is physically able to fully participate in and complete all phases of the CLEET Basic Peace Officer Certification Academy as mandated in CLEET rules.
- Must submit all required documentation and enrollment materials.
- No illegal drug use in last 7 years
- Written general knowledge exam—(Minimum score 80%)
- Background investigation
- Health examination and drug screen

Training and Activities

- Attend CLEET Academy (16 weeks usually on Tuesday and Thursday evenings and some weekend days)
- Pepper spray and Taser certification
- Qualify on the range with handgun, shotgun, and patrol rifle
- Devote a minimum of 24 hours per month
- Extensive on-the-job training with a field training officer
- Provide traffic control and security at public events:
 - 4th of July Celebration
 - Parades
 - Foot and bicycle races
- Regular in-service training
- Provide courtroom security
- May qualify to work paid patrol shifts after successful completion of all training and requirements
