Business

1. Request to approve Ordinance No. 1510 limiting capacity of certain commercial business to 10 patrons at any one time and imposing spacing requirements in order to prevent spread of contagious disease pursuant to civil emergency authority and 11 O.S. § 22-120; and authorizing Mayor to take action further limiting or closing such businesses if Coronavirus spread continues to worsen in Tulsa County; and declaring an emergency. Mayor Lee introduced the item and discussed why it was being discussed. Dr. Dart from the Tulsa Health Department spoke about COVID-19 and answered questions from the Council. City Manager Chris Shroul talked about the decision-making process and the reasoning at capping certain businesses to 10 patrons. Police Chief Arthur informed Council how the Police Department would be enforcing this limit and how they are handling the current crisis. Dr. Dart then answered more questions from Council. Josh Driskell (Jenks Chamber of Commerce) addressed Council about their interactions with local businesses and answered questions. Mike Pierce (Select Fitness & Training) addressed the Council about the steps they were taking to help prevent the spread. Council gave their final thoughts on the Ordinance.
